

# Lakers lose at home, the skid continues.

## Wisconsin Wilderness 4 Fort Frances Lakers 3

At Ice For Kids Arena in Fort Frances the visiting Wilderness built up a three-goal lead and withstood a Lakers comeback attempt to win 4-3.

James Kline and Keith Tessin would give Wisconsin a 2-0 lead before the 12-minute mark of the opening period.

A Phil Jennrich blast on the power play would make it a one-goal contest after 20 minutes.

The only marker of the middle stanza came courtesy of Andrew Anderson who put Wisconsin up a pair after two periods of play.

Austin Adduono would then put the Wilderness up three early in the final frame.

Tyler Stevenson would then strike during a Lakers' man advantage opportunity to cut the deficit in half while Jace Baldwin added another with three seconds remaining to round out the scoring.

Jake Hebda would make 27 saves to pick up the win between the pipes for Wisconsin. Tyler Ampe faced 22 shots in a losing cause for Fort Frances.

With the win the Wilderness reclaimed first place alone in the SIJHL standings. They now have 45 points with their 21-6-3 record one point ahead of Dryden and two more than Thunder Bay while the Lakers (19-11-3) are fourth with 41.
